Missions

Sangkham Canaan Church, Cambodia

- Pray that the believers will not hesitate to share the gospel with their family and relatives. Rachel's aunt passed away last month without professing faith in Christ as the few Christians in the family hesitated to speak openly to her about Jesus through her more than thirty years of struggling with a congenital heart valve condition and her final weeks of being critically ill for fear of causing offence.
- Praise God that Meng Heng's 35 year old uncle, who was also a cousin of Sambath and Mouryngim, responded, confessed his sins and placed his trust in Christ two weeks before his death after Annie visited him in the hospital and shared the message of salvation. He had multiple organ failure due to years of smoking and alcohol addiction. Praise God that God's grace reached him before it was too late.
- Pray for the late uncle's family, especially his mother, a long-time believer attending another church, who opted to hold a traditional Buddhist funeral and declined Sangkham church's offer to conduct a Christian funeral and cover the funeral expenses. Sadly, no mention was made of his confession of faith or his salvation throughout the funeral ceremonies as the Christians in the family remained silent, constrained by the powerful cultural expectations surrounding death and ancestral traditions.
- Pray for the Cambodian Christians as in the Cambodian society, preserving family honour and maintaining harmony with relatives often take precedence over openly identifying with Christ. Their greatest challenge is when families focus entirely on extending physical life at any cost when sickness strikes while conversations about eternity and condition of the soul are frequently neglected because of fear.
- Pray that Cambodian Christians will have greater courage in sharing the gospel with their family members and not be ashamed of the gospel (Rom. 1:16). The percentage of Christian population is very small with many having limited biblical grounding and they face intense social pressure. Pray for the believers as they are often compelled to participate in Buddhist funeral rites, burn incense and join the monk's rituals. Pray that the gospel light will illuminate many dark hearts and save them from more heartache.
