## Sangkhim Canaan Church, Cambodia

- Praise God that each of the 5 students from different parts of the country who enrolled for the ten months residential discipleship course in The Bible Centre in January 2025 carries unique life challenges. Though still young in faith, they share a sincere passion of learning God's Word and a desire to teach it more accurately. They have made a significant sacrifice in taking a year off from work to study as many of their families are financially dependent on them.
- Praise God that the Sangkhim team are deeply encouraged to witness their growth and transformation as they experience life in the new environment these past four months. Their curriculum includes ten modules from the Bible Training Centre for Pastors (BTCP) taught by TBC trainers who are certified by BTCP (USA) to teach this material in the Khmer language.
- Praise God that the hands-on experiences through their participation in Sangkhim church's camp ministries have inspired them to implement similar initiatives in their home churches after graduation in October. The students are also learning other skills such as ministry and life skills, basic counselling, cross-cultural awareness, hygiene and technical skills.
- Pray for these students as they are seeking the Lord's guidance for their next step after graduation as most are considering furthering their studies for another two years at a Bible school. Pray that the Lord will lead them to the right place and provide financial support. Some of them may have to return to their home churches, find work to support themselves and serve faithfully in their local ministries.
